



Clos Apalta was awarded perfect 100 points In latest James Suckling Chilean annual Report

Santiago de Chile, May 26th 2017.

We are proud to announce that Clos Apalta has once again been highlighted as a perfect wine. **This morning it was James Suckling of 100 points to the 2014 vintage.** The world-renowned journalist and wine critic made his fifth trip to Chile, where he tasted nearly 800 wines for his yearly report and Clos Apalta was on top of the chart.

It is important to remember that in 2008, Clos Apalta 2005 vintage was chosen as the TOP 1 Wine of the World by Wine Spectator magazine in their yearly TOP100. Clos Apalta is the only Chilean and Latin American wine that has ever received this award.

Clos Apalta was founded by Alexandra Marnier-Lapostolle and her husband Cyril de Bournet, members of the famous family dedicated from 1827 to craft fine wines and spirits. Today it is his son, Charles de Bournet, who leads the company as the CEO of all its operations.

"We are incredibly honored with this new recognition. It is yet another milestone for Clos Apalta but also a statement that Chilean wines can reach the highest levels of quality. Twenty years ago, we had the vision that this was possible. It is also a very important recognition for the commitment showed from the whole team for searching the highest quality in all the steps of the way that lead to the creation of Clos Apalta." said Charles de Bournet.



The team responsible of Clos Apalta is Technical Director & Winemaker Jacques Begarie, under the advice of the famous winemaker Michel Rolland that is personally involved in the whole production of Clos Apalta.

James Suckling described this new version of the wine as extremely aromatic and focused with full body, very linear and ultra-fine tannins with most polished and beautiful definition of this wine ever.
